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Report of IQAC Conducted Activities for the Academic Session 2022-23

Looking at the need for an hour, the IQAC of the institute organized a national-level seminar in collaboration with the departments of Sociology and the department of Pali-Prakrit on 26 July 2022, guiding the teaching fraternity to enhance their skill with modern teaching tools via online sessions. The resource persons were Dr.AvinashTalmale and Dr Ashish Shende.

Going ahead on the same line, the IQAC organized One Day NAAC Sponsored Conference, New Teaching Methods in Higher Education: Introducing Technology was organized on 01 October 2022, in Hybrid Mode in which different sessions were devoted to Modern Teaching Methods. Dr. Devendra Kawdey attended the conference as a NAAC representative and delivered a keynote address. Dr.Subhashree Mukherjee and Prof Dilip Barad, M. K. Bhavnagar University, Gujrat were the resource persons for offline and online sessions respectively.

To get associate with society, an extended social activity was carried out under the banner of IQAC in which 26 students of the Institute, representing all classes, assisted the Maharashtra Federation of organize White Cane Day on 16 October 2022.

Aiming towards the all-round development of students, IQAC organized a workshop on Competitive Examination in collaboration with the concerned committee, a self-defense training camp for girl students, and a disaster management camp for all students in collaboration March 2023, training for girl students from 25 March to 30 March, and disaster management training on 31 March 2023.
