A Brief History of the Unit:

Vasantrao Naik Govt. Institute of Arts and Social Sciences, Nagpur formerly known as Morris College had no regular NCC unit on its campus though students of this college use to register themselves in different NCC units from open. In the post-reaccreditation period of NAAC, in 2014 with the suggestion by the NAAC Peer-Team, this unit of 2 MAH ARTY BTY, NCC was established with a cadet strength of 50 (SD/SW) cadets. Dr. Jairam Khobragade, Director, VNGIASS then was the true patron behind the establishment of this unit. The present office of NCC in the premises of historic Independence Hall was also established same time. In 2016, the OIC, 2 MAH ARTY BTY, NCC, Col. Sunil Karande having seen potential of the institute, doubled the strength and since then, we have a strength of 100 (SD/SW) cadet in the institute. One another feather was added in the crown when the open unit of 2 MAH ARTY BTY, NCC with a strength of 50 (SD/SW) cadets was also attached with this unit and that is functional till date for training and administrative purposes. Thus, through this unit, the institute is catering to the needs of aspiring cadets of nearby educational institutes not having NCC unit in their campus.

In a very short period of about roughly ten years, this unit has created an identity of its own among the students, among the departments in the institute, in the group headquarter and of course in the society in its limited sense. From the establishment of this unit in the institute, many students have completed their training and have earned the certificates with excellent grades and some of them have joined armed forces, paramilitary forces, Railway Police force, Maharashtra Police and other private security organizations also. Cadets of this unit have also joined the India Army through Agniveer scheme in the recent years and some others are preparing for SSB and CDS exams.

ANO's Profile:

Capt. Somnath Barure is the in-charge of this department since the inception of this unit in 2014. Initially he was recognized CTO till his completion of PRCN in March 2016. After PRCN he got designated as Lieutenant. He has been awarded with the award of "Best ANO" for the year 2021-2022 by the NCC Group Head Quarters, Nagpur for his contribution to the

cause of NCC. He has completed all necessary trainings from time to time and recently, on 14th March 2024 he is been promoted to the rank of Captain.
