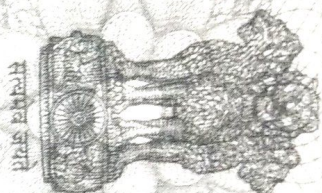

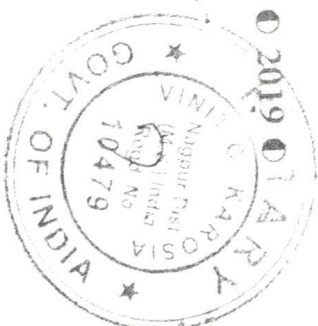

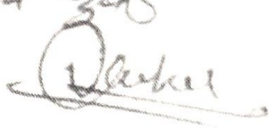

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

This MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in economic development of the country through establishing enterprises. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

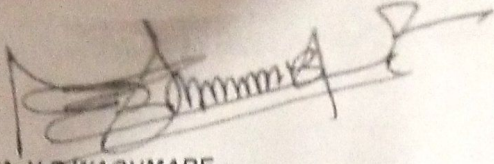

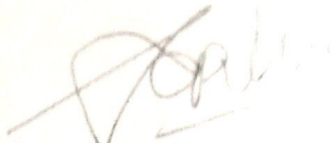
CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

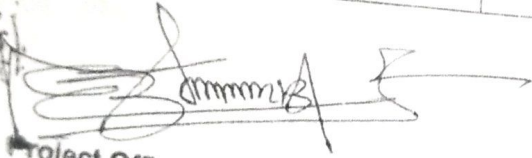

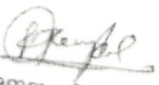

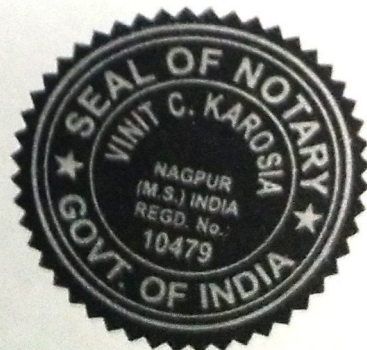

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 20 Oct. day of 2022

Between

The Central Sanskrit University, Delhi, established under Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 passed by the Parliament, hereinafter referred to as the CSU, represented by its Registrar or any of its officers authorised by the Vice Chancellor, CSU

And

Vasantrao Naik Government Institute of Arts And Social Sciences Nagpur

hereinafter referred as VNGIASS represented by its Principal/Registrar/Director/Dean/HOD/Vice Chancellor

This MOU witnesses as under-

1. Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate disseminate and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Non Formal Sanskrit Education (NFSE) activity.
2. And whereas for implementing its NFSE activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and general public within its reach, through NFSE Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.
3. And whereas, pursuant to the proposal submitted by **Vasantrao Naik Government Institute Of Arts And Social Sciences Nagpur** for running of NFSE Centre, the CSU intends to collaborate with it for opening of the NFSE Centre in its premises and sign the MOU therefore.

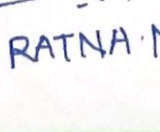
4. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements and material for conducting the prescribed courses in this NFSE Centre-
- a. Trained Sanskrit Teacher.
 - b. Prescribed monthly remuneration to be paid by CSU. (In addition to his duties in the allotted Centre, he may be required to teach the learners at any other nearby Centre/Centres if required).
 - c. Reading material for the learners
 - d. Prescribed guidelines for NFSE
 - e. Conducting examination at the end of academic session and awarding certificate/diploma to the successful candidates.
5. And whereas, the CSU will undertake Sanskrit education for Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language and Diploma in Sanskrit language of the duration of one year each for the learners in NFSE Centre. Learners enrolled in the Centre will be required to deposit prescribed Registration fee to the CSU.
6. And whereas **Vasantrao Naik Government Institute Of Arts And Social Sciences Nagpur** will provide the facilities and extend support as under-
- a. Suitable arrangements for functioning of NFSE Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity etc.
 - b. Nominating a faculty member as authorised officer to coordinate functioning of the Centre. He will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted as per the provisions prescribed in the guidelines for NFSE.
 - c. Publicising the Sanskrit learning courses of CSU in non formal mode and also making arrangement of the same at its Centre.
7. And whereas in any matter concerning the NFSE Centre or any issue arising in conducting the courses, the same will be resolved jointly by the authorised officers of CSU and **Vasantrao Naik Government Institute Of Arts And Social Sciences Nagpur**.
8. This MOU will be valid initially for one academic session and may be extended mutually.
- Now, therefore, in witness whereof, this MOU is executed and signed by the officers of CSU and **Vasantrao Naik Government Institute Of Arts And Social Sciences Nagpur**.

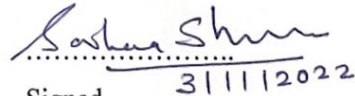

Memorandum of Understanding

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed upon. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning salary, travel funding, health insurance, and housing will be worked out between the institutes. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details including the term of exchange of any intellectual property.

b. Student Exchange

THE DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIOLOGY AT SETH KESARIMAL PORWAL COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE AND COMMERCE KAMPTÉE DIST NAGPUR 441001, and VASANTRAO NAIK GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, NAGPUR agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period to undertake a pre-determined program of study or research.

a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.

b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as a full-time student at his/her home institution.

c) An exchange student will be considered a full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.

d) His/her program of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.

e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.

f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.

g) SETH KESARIMAL PORWAL COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE AND COMMERCE KAMPTÉE DIST NAGPUR 441001, and VASANTRAO NAIK GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, NAGPUR agree to provide suitable accommodation and living expenses for student exchange.

h) To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home universities.

i) The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

c. Other Areas:

(i) to exchange information on research and educational programs.

(viii) Co-supervising post-graduate students,

(ix) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work.

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other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during this MoU shall be vested in both institutes to this Memorandum.

Both institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for registration. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing.

Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.

THE DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIOLOGY AT SETH KESARIMAL PORWAL COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE AND COMMERCE KAMPTEE DIST NAGPUR and VASANTRAO NAIK GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, NAGPUR shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for its own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical, and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for Three years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either department may terminate the MoU by giving written notice six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither SETH KESARIMAL PORWAL COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE AND COMMERCE KAMPTEE DIST NAGPUR nor VASANTRAO NAIK GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, NAGPUR will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer.

However, SETH KESARIMAL PORWAL COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE AND COMMERCE KAMPTEE DIST NAGPUR and VASANTRAO NAIK GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, NAGPUR will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 7: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

ARTICLE 8: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating faculties, staff, and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the laws of the host countries and the rules and regulations of the institutions.
